

What is Ethics?

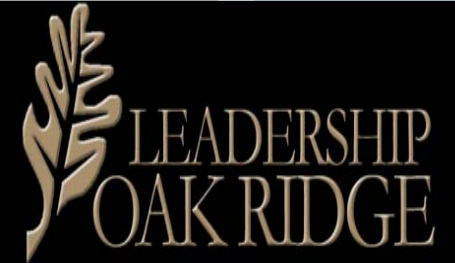
