Tuition is \$1,200 (non-refundable) per person and covers all activities for the participant.

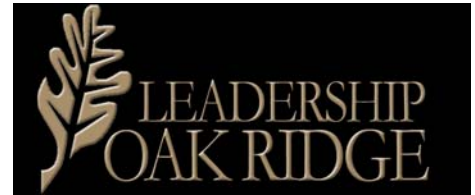
